



GENERAL INFORMATION

This utility vehicle is especially designed for off-road transportation of cargo and passengers. Its construction allows for operation on rough terrain on inclines not exceeding 20%.


CONTROLS AND INDICATORS

ELECTRIC BED LIFT

The electric bed lift switch (1) is located on the instrument panel to the right of the key switch (**Figure 2**). To lift the bed, pull up and hold the toggle switch in the upper position. Release switch to stop lifting operation. To close the bed, press down and hold switch in the lower position. The bed lift will make a loud clicking sound to signal the bed is in the rest position.

TURN SIGNAL

The turn signal control is mounted to the left of the steering column. Push the handle down to indicate a left turn; push the handle up to indicate a right turn.






Figure 1 Battery

HORN

The horn button is located on the floorboard to the left of the brake pedal. Press the button with your left foot to sound the horn. **See Vehicle Feature Identification on page 5.**

PRE-OPERATION AND DAILY SAFETY CHECKLIST

- Safety and information decals: Check to be sure all safety and information decals are in place. See pages 4 through 5 of this supplement.
- Tires: Check for proper tire pressure. See Vehicle Specifications on page 8.
- Turn signal: Check to be sure turn signal is operating correctly.

PERFORMANCE INSPECTION

• Park brake: When latched, the park brake should lock the wheels and hold the vehicle stationary (on an incline of 20% or less).

DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS

A WARNING

• To help prevent overturning the vehicle, drive slowly straight up and down slopes. Avoid driving the vehicle on slopes exceeding 20% incline.
